Membership

The mandate of the AAE is to foster excellence in the teaching of adults by providing opportunities to adult educators; to explore and to enhance professional development by sharing best practices, reviewing evidence based literature and promoting gold standards with adult education. Anyone with a professional interest in the teaching of adults shall be eligible for membership in AAE.

Regular Membership in the AAE is restricted to active and active reserve members of the Nova Scotia Teachers Union. This is ideally suited for full-time, probationary, term and auxiliary Faculty and Professional Support employees of the Nova Scotia Community College. An active reserve member (auxiliary faculty and professional support) is not eligible to hold elected office; however, they may vote and serve on committees.

Student Intern Membership in the AAE is available to full-time university students enrolled in education programs. A student intern member is not eligible to vote or hold elected office; however, they may serve on committees.

Subscriber Membership in the AAE is available to anyone who is not a regular or student intern member. This is ideally suited for Academic Chairs, Principals and Deans of the Nova Scotia Community College, Department of Education employees and Faculty of Teacher Training Institutions. A subscriber member is not eligible to vote, hold elected office or serve on committees.
